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INTRODUCTION & MISSION

Here's what we are all about.

There are over 469,000 orphans in China. These children have been orphaned or abandoned, left in trash heaps, on doorsteps, or in public parks. The vast majority of them are children with special needs of varying severities. They are struggling to survive in orphanages across China that have inadequate facilities, staffing, and resources to meet their needs. Child-to-staff ratios are as high as 40:1, causing these children to receive little to no adult interaction in a day. Babies stay in their cribs for hours on end, and toddlers and school age children are neglected, malnourished, and nameless.



Abandonment and abortion of children with special needs is a shocking reality in China. Due to a lack of awareness regarding disabilities and

little to no resources or support, parents of special needs children often feel scared and helpless in the face of such diagnoses. Medical costs in China are high and life with a special needs child is financially impossible for many families. Often, parents receive pressure from their extended family and friends telling them that this child is simply "not worth it." Countless parents of special needs children decide that giving up their child is the only option. According to G. Mulheir, an expert in international orphan research, "separating children from their families and placing them in large institutions seriously harms their health and development," making it nearly impossible for children already born with special needs to lead thriving lives.

These children deserve better.

Hope Station serves children who are orphaned in Asia by raising up champions and caregivers who are motivated by love and equipped to care for their unique needs. We partner with local and international organizations and people to provide real and lasting solutions for vulnerable children through caregiver training, support for child care centers, adoption advocacy and support, and raising community awareness. The children we serve move from simply surviving towards thriving.

We believe that every child deserves the chance to experience life to the fullest. With this in mind, Hope Station's ultimate goal is to see each and every child in a loving, forever-family. However, recognizing that many children will never have the chance to be adopted or reunited with their families, we strive to ensure that each child is surrounded by loving and dedicated caregivers, therapists, and community members. Our vision is for every child to have a champion in their life who is uniquely equipped with the love, knowledge and skills to guide the child through healthy growth and development.

Hope Station currently operates in China with the support of the **Chinese Relief and Development Foundation** (CRDF), a Chinese nonprofit organization in Sichuan province. CRDF functions as Hope Station's umbrella organization and provides administrative support, networking connections, and financial and legal guidance.

With CRDF's assistance, Hope Station is actively working with a **local orphanage**, outside of Chengdu. Each week, we host activities for the children, provide therapy services for children with special needs, and offer support and training to the staff. We have successfully advocated for several children's adoptions and continue to do so. The goal is to create more partnerships like this with more orphanages in the future.

WHO ARE THE CHAMPIONS?

Hope Station strongly believes that each child deserves to have a loving, forever family of their own. Forever parents are the ultimate champion for a child, especially a child with unique needs, cherishing them and fighting for them. Unfortunately, most children with special needs are abandoned by their parents and forced to live as orphans for a very long time if not forever. These children are just as deserving of having an adult to champion them. For orphaned children, champions are their **nannies**, **therapists**, **social workers**, **foster parents**... anyone who makes the commitment to do whatever it takes for the child thrive.

GOAL: MINDSET SHIFT AMONG CAREGIVERS

We want caregivers who are *motivated by love*. Love is the cornerstone of family. There is no comparison to the love a parent has for their child. That's why we believe it's so important that champions who stand in the gap should be motivated by the same kind of unconditional love. When a child's caregiver is motivated by love to care for him, he can live a thriving life no matter the obstacles.

GOAL: SKILL SET SHIFT AMONG CAREGIVERS

We want caregivers who are *equipped to care* for their children. Caring for orphaned children with special needs is a tough job. Helping them to move from surviving to thriving requires a very special skill set. Those with special needs have an especially difficult time surviving in a harsh environment with no one to fight their battles for them. Our vision is for every child have a champion in their life who is uniquely equipped with the knowledge and skills they need to guide the child through healthy growth and development.


GOAL: MINDSET SHIFT AMONG COMMUNITY

Due to these circumstances beyond our control, we shifted our focus to provide lasting solutions to real life problems that the children and orphanages face.

Going forward, Hope Station continues to support children and caregivers in orphanages. In 2017, we provided resources, hosted activity days, advocated for adoptions, conducted therapy, and modeled positive childcare practices at the orphanage we serve. Children and caregivers alike showed positive growth and learning as a result of our efforts.
