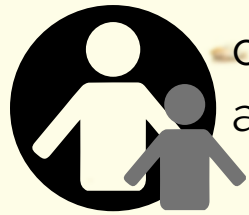

# 2018

We partner with local and international organizations and people to provide real and lasting solutions for vulnerable children through caregiver training, support for child care centers, adoption advocacy and support, and raising community awareness. The children we serve move from simply surviving towards thriving.

# WHAT HAPPENED IN 2018



## One-on-One Volunteer Program

Over **50 children** received **one-on-one play time** with **32 Hope Station volunteers**. Through these sessions, the children are valued and loved, which increases their self-esteem and teaches them social skills.

## Therapy Program

Hope Station staff carried out **over 75 behavioral therapy sessions**. Hannah worked towards goals that were uniquely designed to help her become more independent. She **mastered 10 new skills**, and she **began progress on over 15 more**.



## Caregiver Training

**Over 8 orphanage caregivers** received **support and training** from Hope Station professionals in 2018. They gained knowledge and skills that improve the quality of life for all the children in their care.

## Adoption Advocacy and Transition Support

Hope Station **advocated for 2 children (Ezra and Eli)** to be adopted internationally, and provided **transition support for 1 local family** and their new son **Lincoln**. We also continued supporting **4 children and their families** that went through adoption in previous years.
